Erratum for the TOMs AAC adapted scale

The third edition of Therapy Outcome Measures for Rehabilitation Professionals' (Enderby and John, 2015) details on page 102 that it is necessary to consider and score the activity, participation and well-being without AAC and with AAC. This has not been found to be practical and it has been decided that clients should be rated in the same way as on other adapted scales i.e. as they present at a particular time point: initial, intermediate (if required) and at end of episode of care or discharge.
